

FOX ENTERPRISES, INC California Proposition 65 Warning Statement

The official name of Proposition 65 is the "Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986". Proposition 65 is a California law that applies to any products sold in California or products that Californians purchase, in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment.

Proposition 65 requires businesses to provide warnings to Californians about significant exposures to chemicals that cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm.

Proposition 65 requires California to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. This list, which must be updated at least once a year, has grown to include approximately 900 chemicals since it was first published in 1987. Proposition 65 enables Californians to make informed decisions about their exposures to these chemicals.

A Proposition 65 warning means one of two things:

- (1) the business has evaluated the exposure and has concluded that it exceeds the "no significant risk level"; or
- (2) the business has chosen to provide a warning simply based on its knowledge about the presence of a listed chemical without attempting to evaluate the exposure.

Fox Enterprises, Inc. ("Fox") has chosen to provide a warning based on its knowledge about the presence of a listed chemical without attempting to evaluate the level of exposure. Products marked or sold by Fox may contain a listed chemical at levels that are below the Proposition 65 level of concern. However, out of an abundance of caution, Fox has elected to place the Proposition 65 warning notification on those affected products containing any of the chemicals/substances listed below:

- 1) Lead
- 2) Nickel
- 3) Antimony Trioxide
- 4) Di(2-ethylhexyl)phthalate (DEHP)
